## DIRECTIONS

**From I84:** Exit 1. End of ramp go left if traveling west, go right if traveling east. After 2nd stop sign, take your next right onto Mopus Bridge Rd. Continue on Mopus Bridge Road, the Farm will be on your right.

**From I684:** Exit 8 Hardscrabble Rd. End of ramp turn right. Go to end of Hardscrabble, turn left onto June Rd. Take 1st right onto Bloomer Rd. Go to end, turn right onto Rt. 121. Take sharp left onto Rt. 116. Take 1st left onto Wallace Rd. Dirt road becomes paved road. Farm will be on your left.

**From Route 7:** Turn onto Rt. 102. Go to end and turn right onto Rt. 35 (Main St. in Ridgefield). Go 1 mile and at blinking light, turn left onto Rt. 116. Follow Rt. 116 and turn right onto Ridgebury Rd. (If you pass Ridgefield High School, you have gone too far). At stop sign, turn left to stay on Ridgebury Rd. Take next left onto Spring Valley Rd. and next left onto Mopus Bridge Rd. Farm will be on right.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

*Every class offered herein which is recognized by USEF, CHJA, or M&S will be conducted and judged in accordance with the current USEF, CHJA, and M&S Rules. To show in CHJA Medal classes, riders MUST be members. In order to compete for CHJA annual year-end awards, the owner of the horse or pony must be a member of the CHJA and the horse or pony must be registered with the CHJA. A copy of the CHJA Rule Books, class specifications, Medal class specifications, and membership applications are available at the show secretary's office and at [www.chja.net](http://www.chja.net)*

1. Every animal entered for competition shall be under the control of show management. Stepping Stone Farm will in no way be responsible for any loss, accident or damage that may occur by fire or otherwise and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor, spectator, trainer and attendant hold Stepping Stone Farm and its members, employees and agents harmless for any loss or damage that may occur to any persons, animals or property at the show.
2. If any questions or disputes arise, same will be referred to the steward & show committee, whose decision shall be final.
3. Exhibitors are responsible for having accurate and current memberships for all organizations which require the same. Any fines levied against the horse show for incorrect exhibitor memberships shall be the responsibility of the exhibitor.
4. \$50 Fee for any returned checks, or unpaid entries that must be billed.
5. Entries close 24 hours prior to show. Post entries \$20.
6. Dogs must be leashed at ALL times
7. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes if warranted.
8. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**USEF Membership Statement - Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.**
